FUNDING CRITERIA

- **Maximum funding available to Full-time students: Up to \$1,500/semester**
 - ✓ A Financial Review Form from the financial aid office at the school is required for full-time students
 - ✓ Documentation/receipt of course registration required for advanced payment to the school, *or* student will be reimbursed upon submission of *original paid receipts*.
- **Maximum funding available to Part-time students: Up to \$1,200/semester**
 - ✓ Book expenses for part-time students only, up to \$200/semester, not to exceed total funding of \$1,200/semester. Original receipts required, payable to student.
 - ✓ Documentation/receipt of course registration required for advanced payment to the school, *or* student will be reimbursed upon submission of *original paid receipts*.
- Students receiving fellowships or tuition grants are not eligible due to limited funding.
- Special Accelerated Programs must have a plan on file and documentation of progress. Maximum funding for accelerated programs is \$4,500.
