## Electric Camping Policy

**Please note: Camping lots are available as per first come; first served basis for RV and Campers, all other campers will need to adhere to the Saturday rule. No tents allowed in the Electrical Camping Area. No one other than the person who paid for the Electric Camping spot can plug into the electrical pedestals.**

### CAMPING RULES:

1. Camping lots must be paid in full before reserving lots; camping cost is \$40.00 per lot for the weekend.
2. Camping is allowed Wednesday, July 30, 2024 – August 04, 2024 no later than 12:00 p.m.
3. Camping is permitted in designated camping areas only.
4. All campers must have a daily pass and or weekend pass for the duration of the pow-wow.
5. No fires are permitted except in designated campfire areas. No outside firewood is allowed, firewood will be provided.
6. Defacing of any property or vegetation is strictly prohibited.
7. The maximum speed limit on campground roads is 10 m.p.h.
8. Alcohol or Drugs shall **NOT** be allowed on the grounds, if caught you will be asked to leave the premises IMMEDIATELY.
9. Any visibly intoxicated, boisterous, or discourteous person(s) will be subjected to immediate removal in addition to any other penalties.
10. There is a strict enforced 10:00 p.m. curfew for anyone under the age of 16, anyone under the age shall be accompanied with an adult (parent or guardian is preferred). Security will inform Authorities for any violations and a citation may be issued.
11. No weapons or firearms are permitted at any time.
12. All campers must abide by all Tribal Rules and regulations. *Please note to view the Tribal Laws, Rules and Regulations please visit [www.ecode360.com/ME2727](http://www.ecode360.com/ME2727)*
13. Pet Policy: Campers are encouraged to please leave pets at home, however if traveling with your furry companion please be sure that that they are leashed/or tied up at all times during the event, with a copy of their vaccination records on hand. The Menominee Indian Tribe will not be liable for any accidents/injuries caused from or to the pet. We would like to keep our Pow-wow as safe as possible for all those in attendance. **Reminder: Please do not leave pets in vehicles and be sure your pet is supervised at all times in the camping area.**

By signing I agree that I have read the above rules for camping at the 2025 Annual Menominee Nation Contest Pow-wow and understand that if any of the rules are broken during the weekend of the Pow-wow (July 31 – August 4, 2025), that I will be asked to leave the grounds immediately, with no refund for the camping spot.
