

Title: Renewable Energy/Solar Installation Internship

Position Location(s)

Solar Installs will be on, or close to the Menominee Reservation. The energy assessments will be at Tribal Commercial properties.

Safety:

On site work will be outside in various fall/winter weather conditions. Hard hats/eye protection may be required on some sites depending on the location.

Duties:

- Assist Tribal Renewable Energy Team and hired contractor on up to five Solar installations, including four ground mount installations and one roof top installation
- Research funding for additional installations
- Update social media on projects
- Assist with assessing and layout for future projects
- Conduct energy efficiency assessments on tribal properties and residential properties
- Educate school aged students on Renewable Energies
- Participate in Community Energy Events
- Be part of the Team!

Requirements:

- Must be a registered college student seeking 6 or more credits
- Must be a degree seeking student at College of Menominee Nation, or another College or University (certain documentation may be required to confirm enrollment status)
- Must have completed one semester of studies
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 or better (based on a 4.0 scale)
